Ideas for increasing & developing adult participation



Volunteer Training

Aim:

To increase the skill level of volunteer members. Volunteer recruitment, retention and benefits. Off-season activities.

Duration: 1 hour – 1 day, on going.

Run by: Head-marshall, Event officer, RYA instructor or member with relevant experience.

Example content:

Personal skills. Marshal training. Group control. Man overboard recovery. Towing sessions. VHF procedures. Club operating procedures/health & safety policy. Event sign-in procedures. How to give the perfect safety briefing etc.

Kit required:

Clubhouse/classroom. Usual club launch site. Whiteboard & marker pens.

Benefits:

Induction for new volunteers. Up-skill current volunteers. Team-building. Retention of volunteers.

Options:

Approach local rescue organisation to assist with training or to offer input. If the club is not an RYA training centre, link up with another clubs training centre or local RYA centre to manage training.
